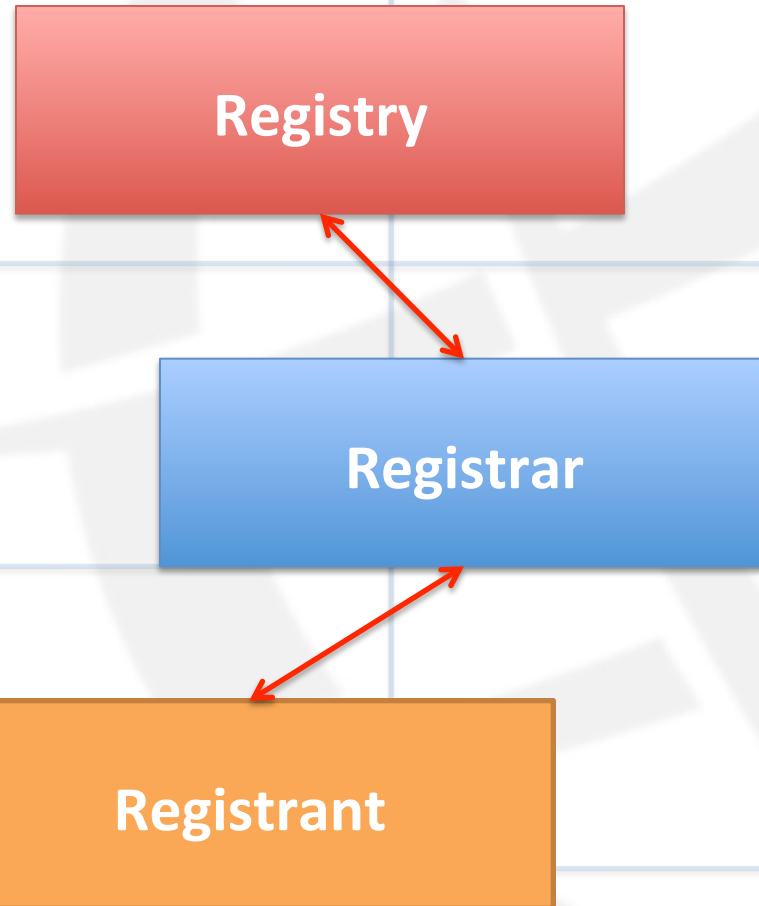

Why a registrar ?

- Competition → Cheaper prices
- You generally don't just need a domain name
- Personalized support in your language and time zone
- One place for all domain names and TLDs
- ...

Who can be a registrar ?

1. ICANN Accreditation
(submitted to financial, operational and technical criteria).
2. Contract with one or more gTLD registry operators.



What about ccTLDs ?

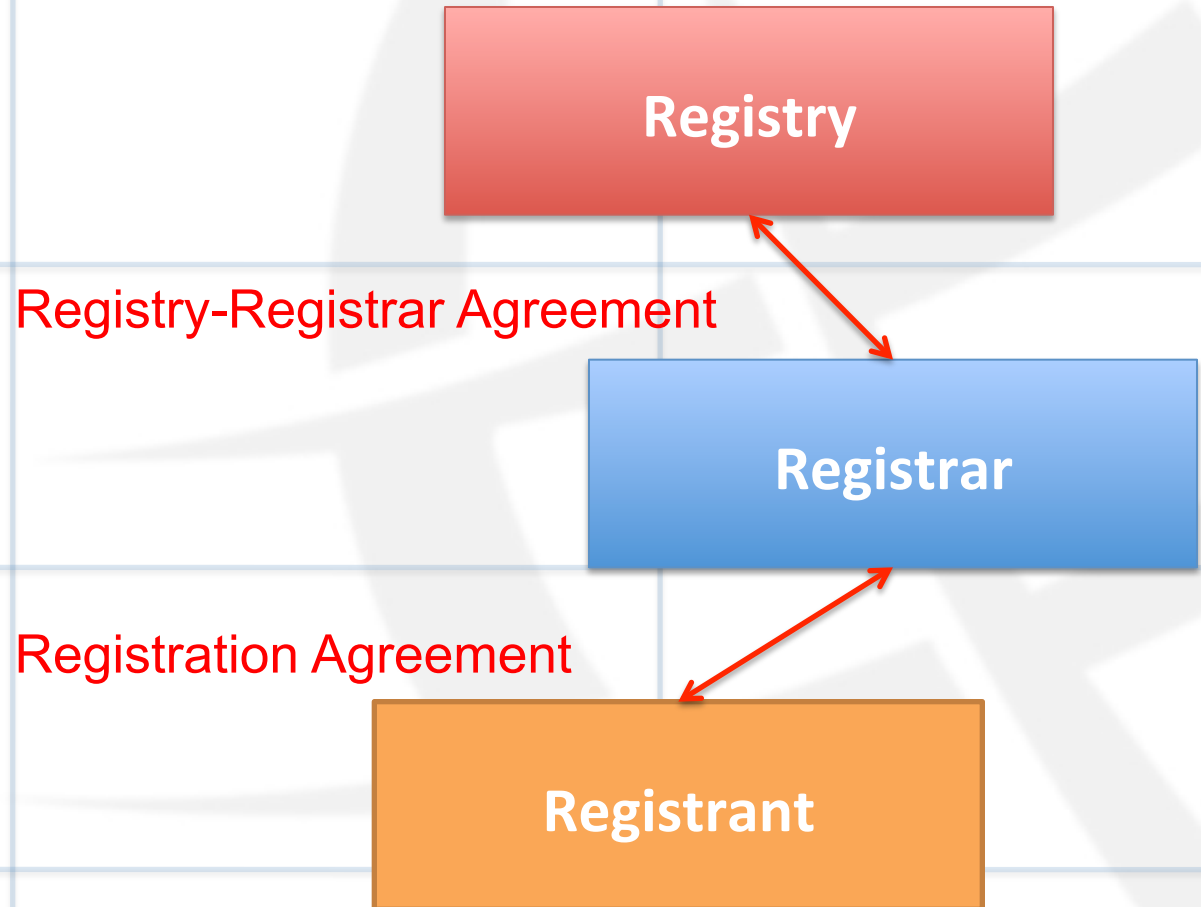
- ICANN accreditation → only gTLDs
- A consistent number of ccTLD registries have adopted a registry-registrar system
- Each operator determines the rules and procedure for accreditation under its ccTLD

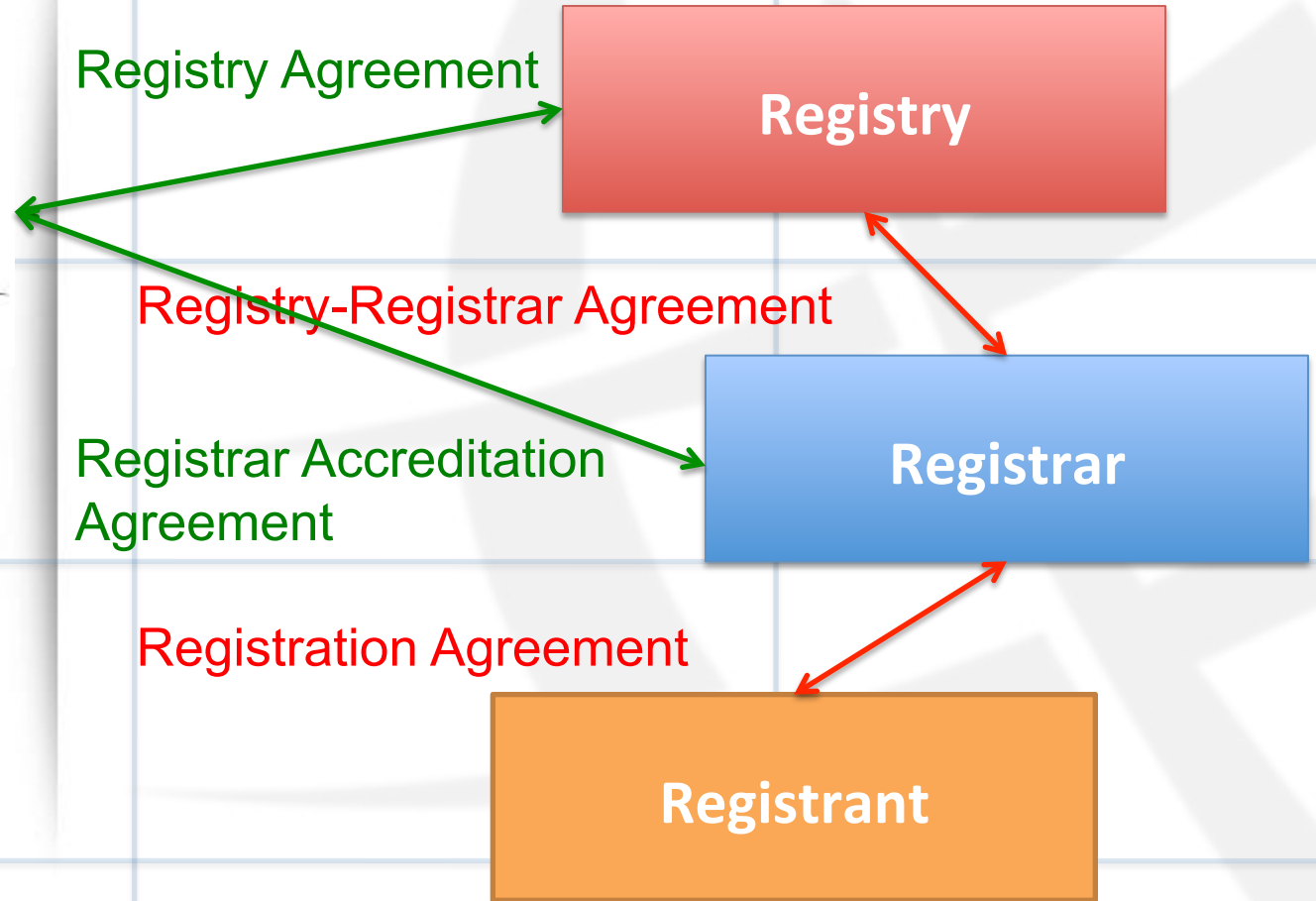

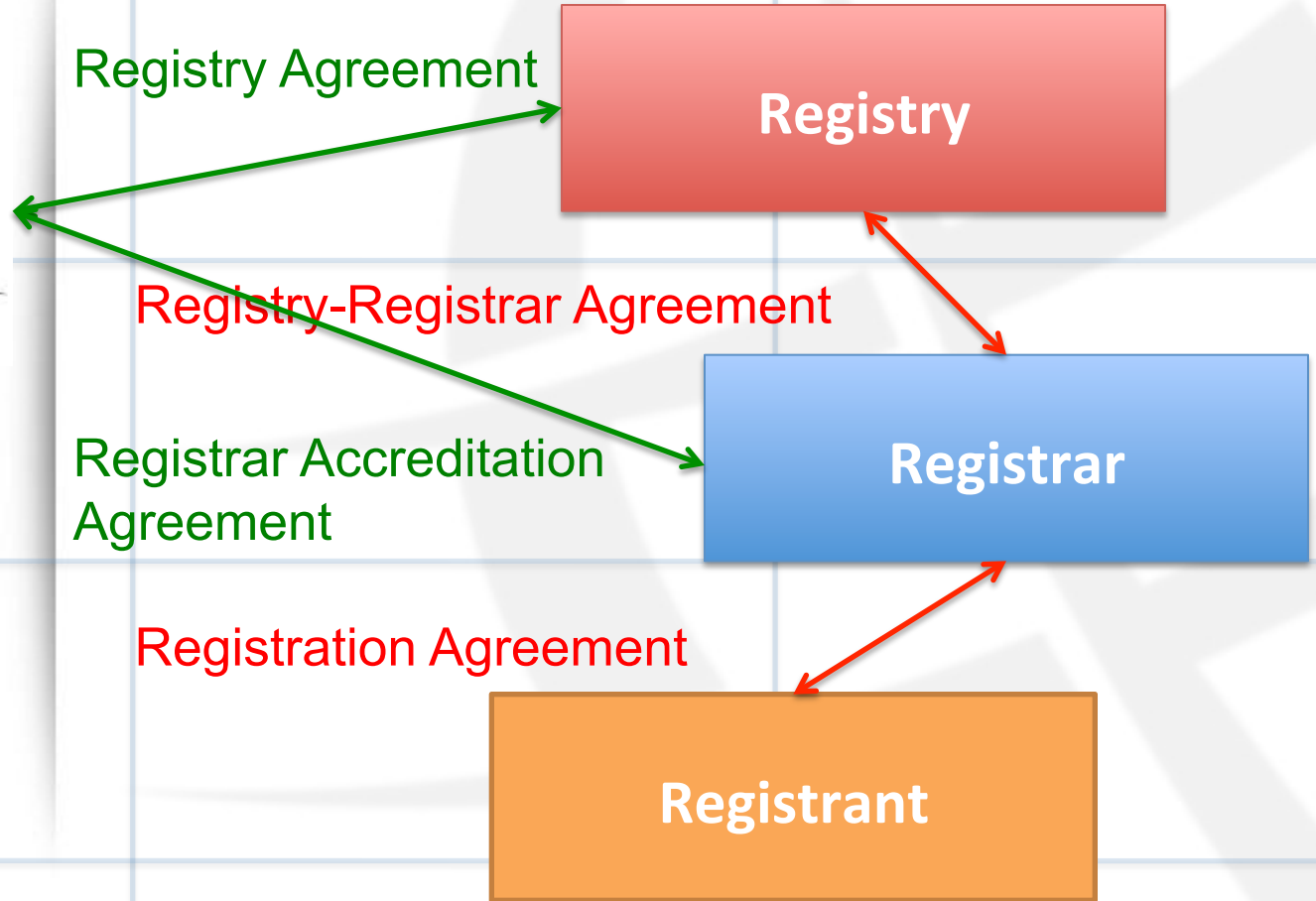
ICANN's [agreements](#) with accredited registrars and with [gTLD](#) registry operators require compliance with various specifically stated procedures and also with "consensus policies." Sponsors and registry operators of sponsored TLDs may be required to comply with consensus policies in some instances.

The following policies are specifically identified as having been adopted as consensus policies by the [ICANN](#) Board of Directors as of the dates shown below.

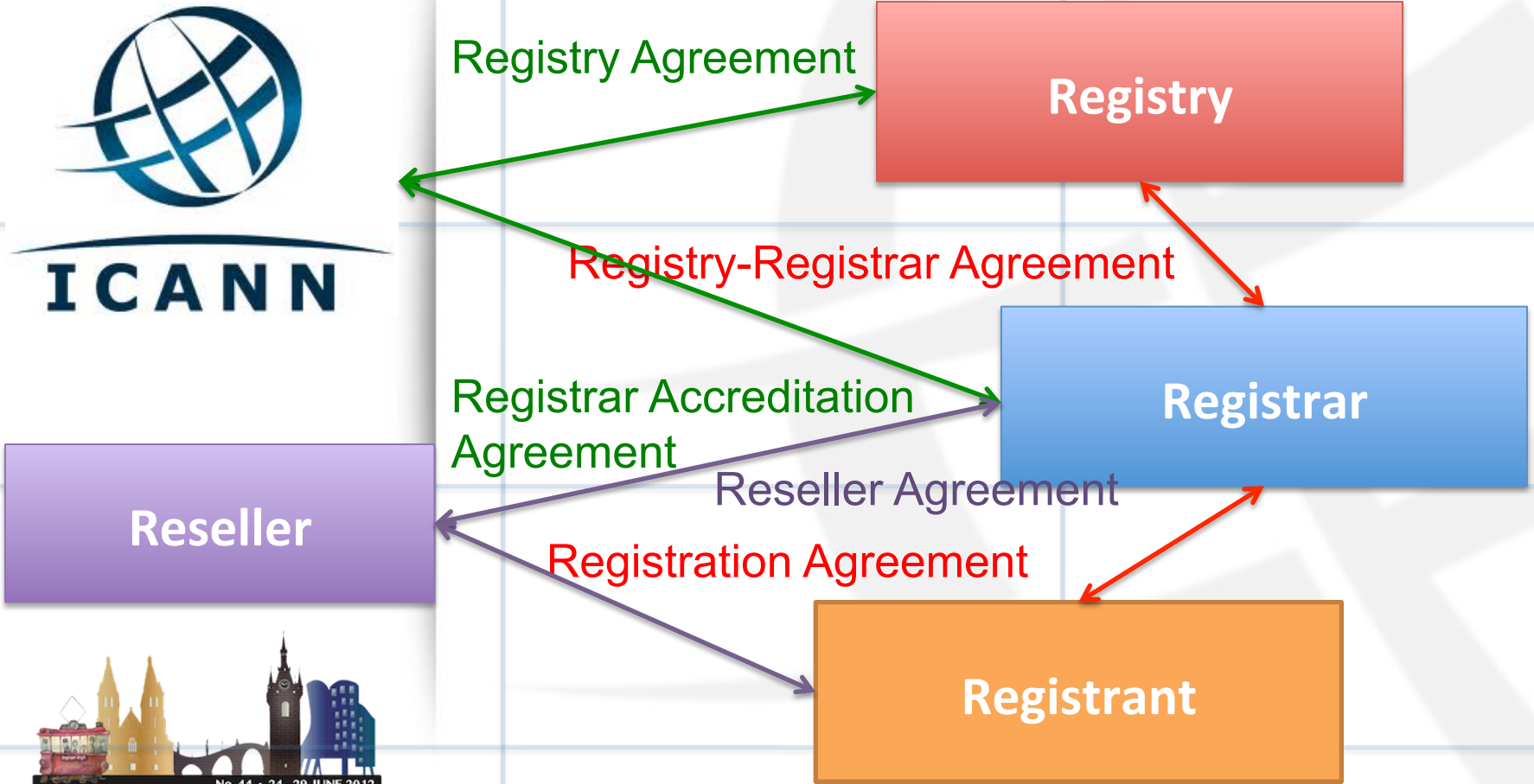
- [Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy](#) (adopted by [ICANN](#) Board 26 August 1999; form of implementation documents approved 24 October 1999).
- [Whois Data Reminder Policy](#) (adopted by [ICANN](#) Board 27 March 2003; implementation documents issued 16 June 2003).
- [Inter-Registrar Transfer Policy](#) (effective on 12 November 2004, adopted by [ICANN](#) Board 25 April 2003; implementation documents issued 13 July 2004).
- [Whois Marketing Restriction Policy](#) (effective on 12 November 2004, adopted by [ICANN](#) Board 27 March 2003; implementation documents issued 12 August 2004).
- [Restored Names Accuracy Policy](#) (effective on 12 November 2004, adopted by [ICANN](#) Board 27 March 2003; implementation documents issued 12 August 2004).
- [Expired Domain Deletion Policy](#) (effective on 21 December 2004, adopted by [ICANN](#) Board 31 October 2003; implementation documents issued 21 September 2004).
- [Registry Services Evaluation Policy](#) (effective on 15 August 2006, adopted by [ICANN](#) Board 8 November 2005; implementation documents posted 25 July 2006)
- [AGP Limits Policy](#) (effective on 1 April 2009, adopted by [ICANN](#) Board on 26 June 2008; implementation documents posted 17 December 2008)

There is a problem

When can ICANN help ?



ICANN can address:

- Violations of a Registry Agreement by a registry
- Violations of a RAA by a registrar
- Violations of a Consensus Policy by a registry or a registrar



ICANN cannot address:

- Ownership issues (→ UDRP or Courts)
- Contractual issues between registrants, registrars and/or resellers
- ccTLD issues
- Issues regarding the use of a domain name (website, spams...)
