### Currently Underway

- Community Wiki to provide updates
  - Updated recommendations from LE community on WHOIS validation and Data Retention (April 30 & May 6<sup>th</sup>)
- Pre-Prague publication of draft RAA documents reflect current status

## Issue Report Request

### Board Requested GNSO PDP on “Remaining Issues”

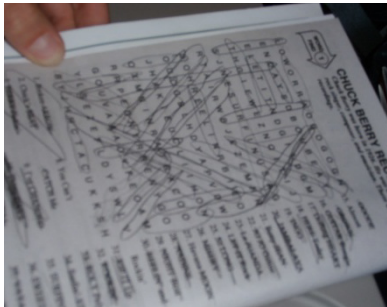
- Final Issue Report Published
- Commencement of PDP to take place after Negotiations conclude



# Current Status of Negotiations

## Informational Documents Posted

- **ICANN RAA Draft-** reflects ICANN's most recent draft, but is **not** a negotiated or approved document
- **Key amendments include:**
  - Verification/Validation of WHOIS/Registrant Data
  - Enhanced Data Collection on registrants
  - Enhanced Reseller Obligations
  - Creation of a Proxy/Privacy Accreditation Program
  - Creation of Abuse Point of Contact
  - Additional Registrar Information
  - Enhanced Compliance Related Obligations
  - Prohibition of Cybersquatting



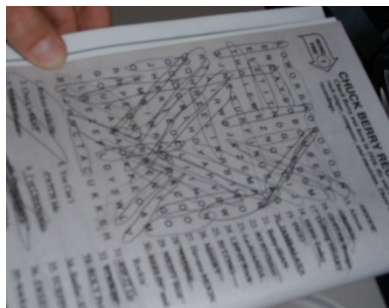

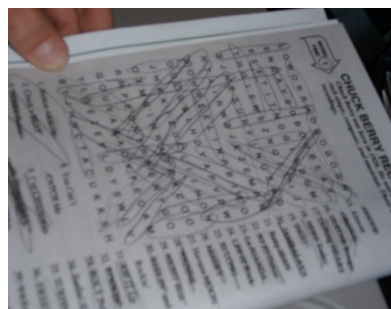
*Goal: to inform the conclusion of the negotiations*

  - Board provides direction that the PDP should begin



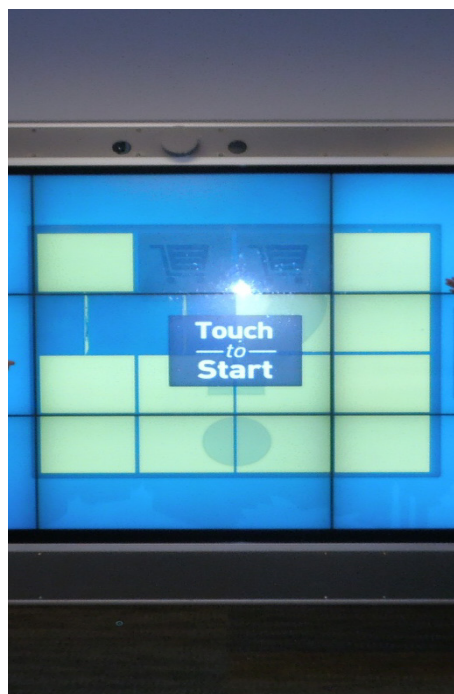


# Next Steps
